Some suggestions to use when preparing/reviewing all minutes:

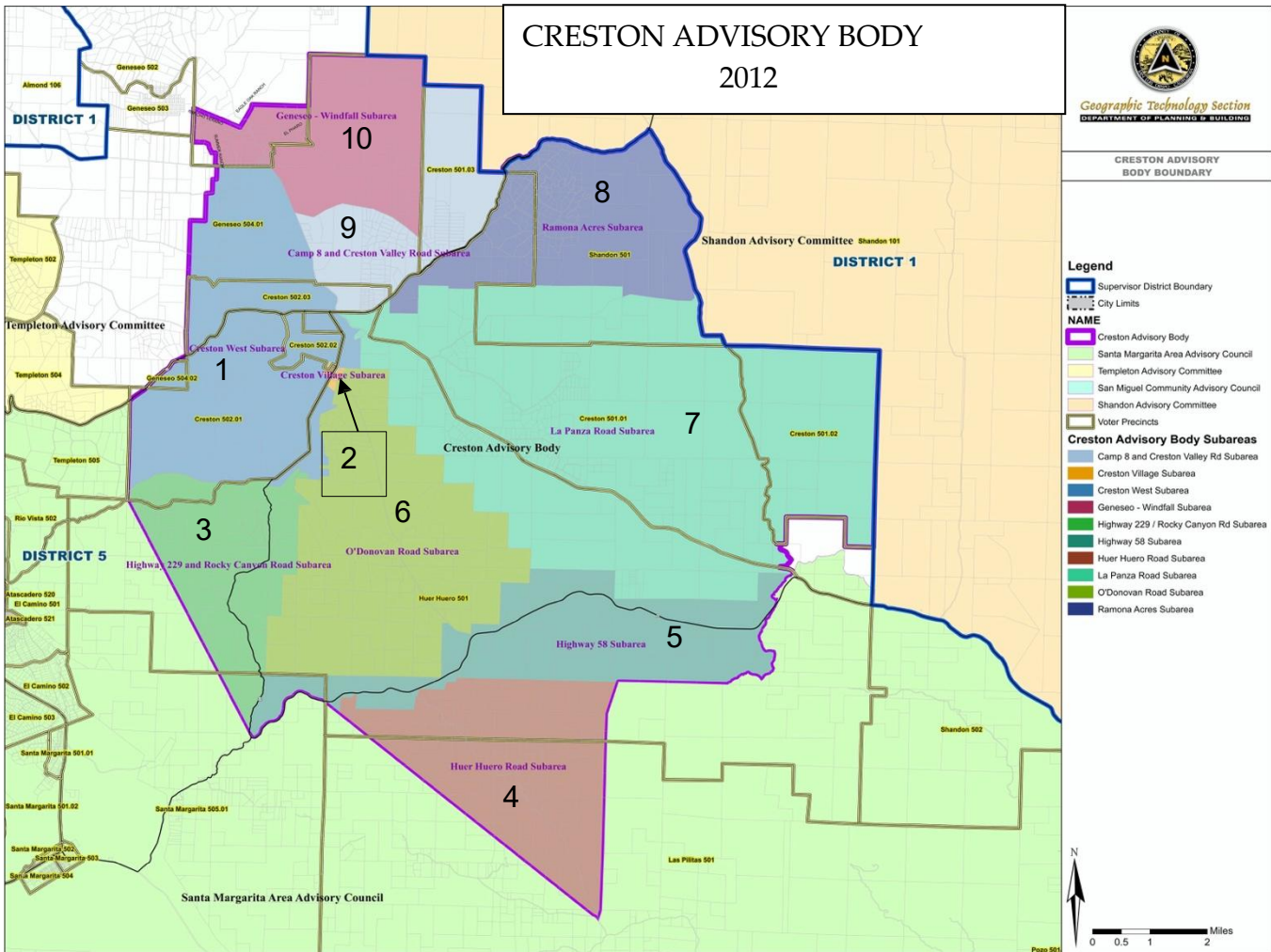
1. Accuracy/spelling of names important to double check.
